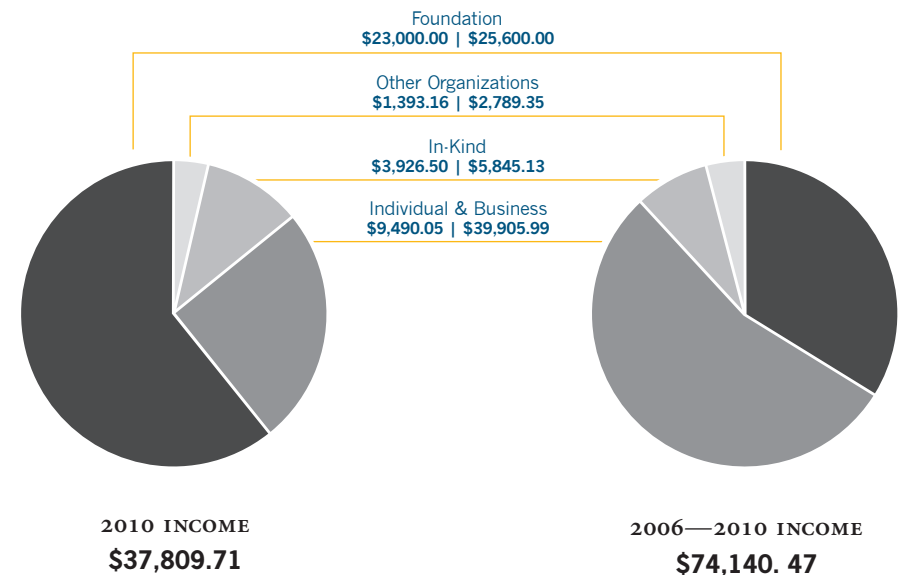
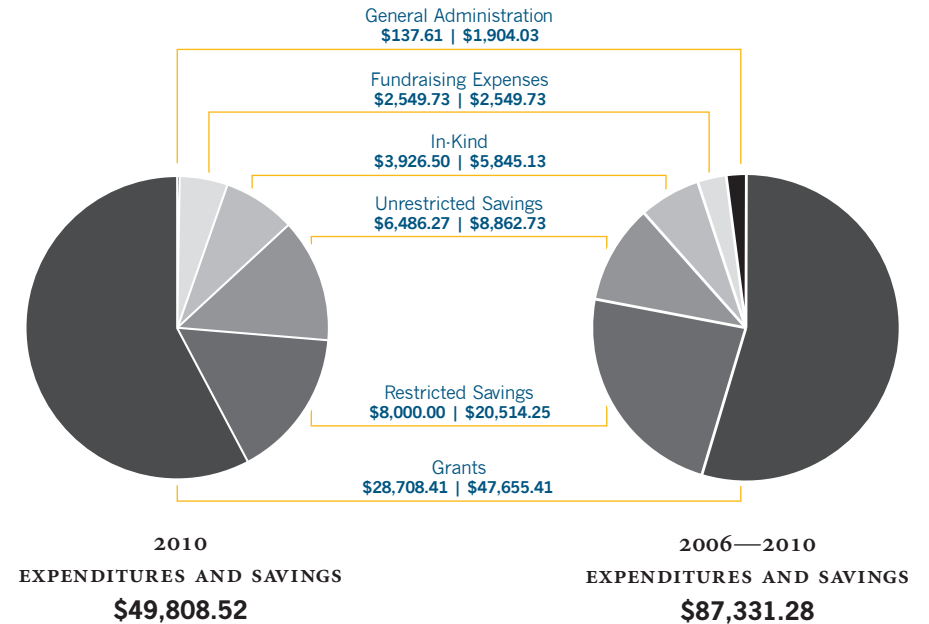

2010 Financial Report

The following report highlights the success of our fundraising efforts and our activities in 2010. In 2010 we raised a total of \$37,809.71 from individuals, businesses and other charitable organizations in support of our efforts. Some of our revenues were received in the form of in-kind goods and services that were critical to our success. These funds were used to launch and operate the TRUMANSBURG KIDS EXPLORE & DISCOVER program and to fund 17 other grants exceeding \$12,500.

Our campaign in 2011 will be focused on raising funds to sustain the TRUMANSBURG KIDS EXPLORE & DISCOVER program, to increase our endowment and continue funding worthy projects that enhance the education of students throughout our school district.
